APTOS TRANSMISSION MAIN RELOCATION PROJECT CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN MARCH 1, 2010


Dear Residents and Property Owners:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that construction of a project to relocate the Aptos sewer force main will begin on or about March 1, 2010, and continue for a period of approximately two years.

A contract for this work has been awarded to Anderson Pacific Engineering Construction. The construction of this project is expected to create some inconvenience for those living in this area and for State park visitors; we request your patience while the work is being completed. Plans have been made to minimize the construction impacts and traffic delays. APTOS TRANSMISSION MAIN SEWER RELOCATION PROJECT

● What to expect during construction:

Throughout construction the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District will work closely with the contractor to minimize inconveniences, however, you should anticipate the following:

- ✓ **Traffic Delays** will be kept to a minimum, however, delays may be expected at various time during the project.
- ✓ **On-Street Parking** in some places will be temporarily blocked.
- ✓ **Driveways** will be temporarily restricted or closed when construction is occurring in the immediate area.
- ✓ **Noise and Dust Levels** will likely increase temporarily.

● These impacts will be minimized by the following measures:

- ✓ **Hours of Construction will be limited to weekdays, 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM.**
- ✓ **Work Notice:** Prior notice will be posted in the vicinity of the work.
- ✓ **Traffic Management** will occur. Temporary lane closures will occur when necessary but only between the hours of 8:15 am and 4:30 pm. Traffic will be controlled by flag persons when lane closures are necessary. All attempts will be made to keep a lane of traffic open during construction.
- ✓ **Advance Written Notice** will be provided prior to restricting access to driveways.
- ✓ **Parking** will be limited in the area of immediate construction. "No parking" signs will be posted along the street identifying the areas with temporary parking restrictions.
- ✓ **Dust Control:** Water trucks and street sweepers will be used to limit the dust.
- ✓ **Construction Signage** will be posted to provide information about the project.
